All of your gear for Trek will be packed in one of **two containers**: In your **5-gallon bucket**, and a **large**, **heavy-duty garbage sack**. The bucket will contain your personal items and the garbage sack will contain your sleeping items.

Please remember to PACK A SACK LUNCH for the bus ride.

Don't forget to label these items with your first and last name and the name of your ward!
